

# “Fall Crazy”

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## Supply List

Pattern provided in class, cost \$8.00.  
Background cotton fabric 22”x 22”  
Shape Flex 101 (fusible interfacing) 14”x 14”  
Borders & Binding – 1/3<sup>rd</sup> yard plaid wool.  
(Wool measures 58”selvage to selvage).  
Warm & Natural cotton batting 22”x 22”.  
Backing cotton fabric 22”x22” (optional for class).

## Wools

When picking out your wools, look for a variety of textures, plaids and colors. If your wool has not been felted, pre-wash it in your machine with warm water. *(I throw it in with my towels).* Dry in a hot dryer. Press if needed.

## Pumpkin

Stem – Brown plaid 3 ½” x 3 ½”.  
Pumpkin – White over dyed 7 ½” x 18”.

## Leaves

6 each, Star shaped Liquidambar leaves 5”x 5” in greens, gold’s & reds.  
3 each, Boysenberry leaves 5”x 6” in reds and oranges.

## Threads & Needles

Pearl Cotton, size 8.  
Used for stitching down the appliqué and for the decorative stitching.

**Leaves & Pumpkin Stem** – Use matching color pearl cotton.

**Pumpkin** – Bring a big assortment of colors in pearl cotton.

**“We want those beautiful decorative stitches to show!!!”**

Chenille needles Size 24 or 22. My favorite is Dritz Crewel needle, size 2.  
The eye needs to be big enough for the pearl cotton to go through.

## Basic Sewing Kit

Scissors for cutting paper, and scissors for cutting wool.  
Appliqué pins. Clover brand are short with a white tip on the ends.  
Freezer paper, pencil and/or sharpie.  
Light box for tracing appliqué patterns.  
Iron and small ironing board.  
12” square of muslin, backed with cotton batting to practice your decorative stitches on.
