

Favorite Photo to Quilt – Supplies

- Kit provided by the teacher will include color photos and pattern examples, Grace's "Perfect Fabric Gray Scale", and her "**Value Tool**". Kit fee payable in class: \$20.00

Supplies student will bring:

- A few clear acetate **write-on** transparency sheets (8 1/2"x11") commonly used for transparency making for overhead projectors. Report covers work excellently.

- - A few of your favorite photos **enlarged to 8 ½ x 11 (page size)**. In these photos please keep the subject matter very simple (one focal point and a simple background). Look for pictures/photos with good contrast and value, and clear lines and shapes. Choose those that are not too dark so that you can see details easily.

- NOTE: Photos NOT to bring to this class - Do not bring people portraits or baby photos. That is for another class. Pet photos are OK but ensure the photo is simple, has good values and good lines. Also, focal points are critical and help us focus on pattern making. Do NOT bring landscapes unless there is a clear focal point and the landscape is just the background.

- - Board – Foam Core 20" x 30"
- - Freezer paper roll – 18" wide
- - Pens: **Extra Fine** "Sharpie" black permanent marker; **Fine** point "Sharpie", one black and one red; and ballpoint
- - T- Pins
- - 22" Quilting Ruler
- - Scissors – paper
- - Vinyl – clear such as a painter's drop cloth 2 Mil. Approximately 20" x 30". Best is the 2 mil. Painter's drop cloth as it is thin enough to see through and work with. Can be bought at any hardware or building supply store.
