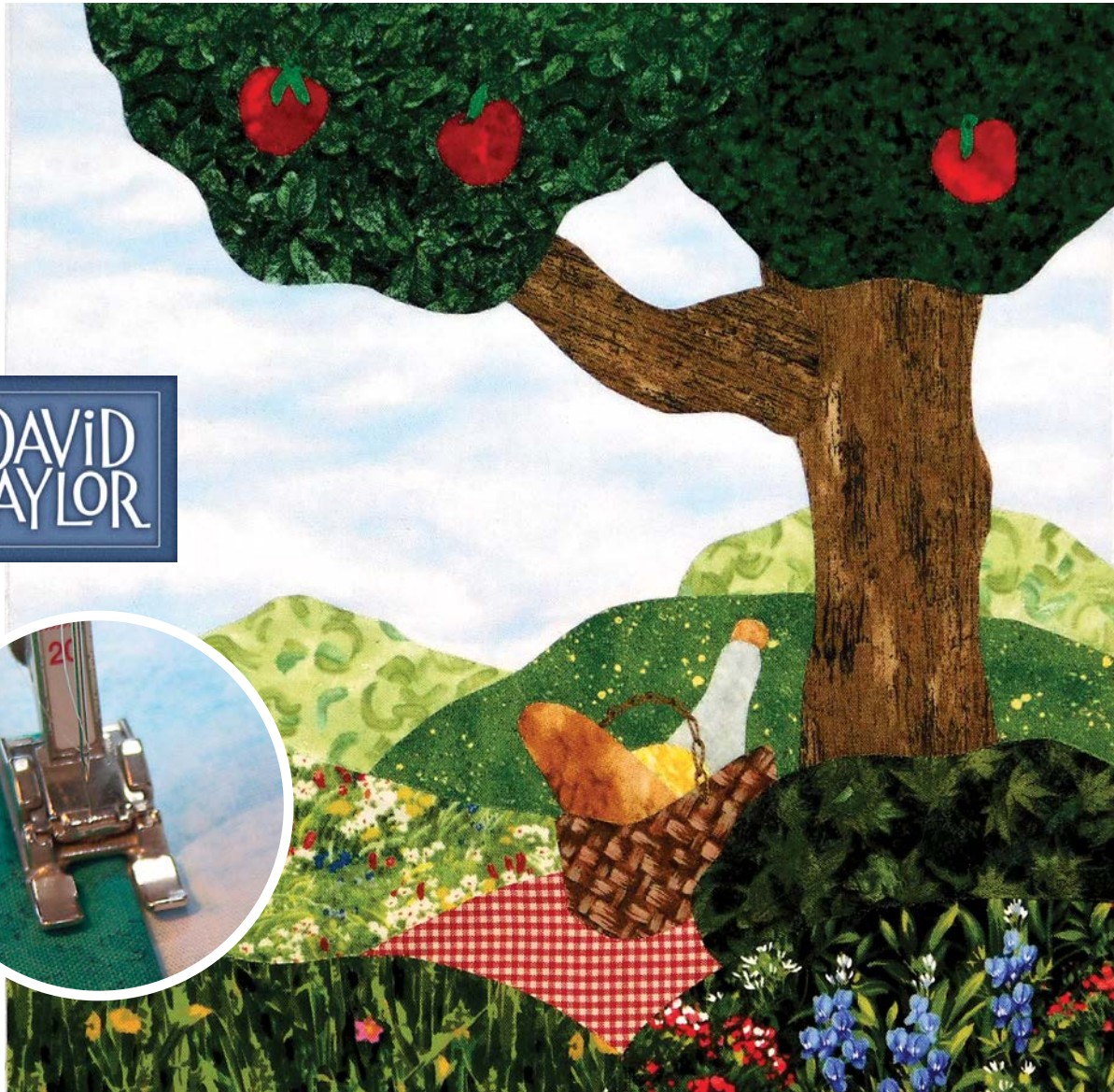


# UNDER *the* APPLE TREE

MACHINE APPLIQUÉ

This workshop demonstrates my machine-appliqué technique with simple applique shapes, using freezer paper templates and liquid starch. Students need to have a sewing machine with 'adjustable blind hem stitch' capability.

**\$25 required kit fee:** *includes pattern, freezer paper, pre-washed fabrics and YLI invisible thread*

## STUDENT EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Sewing machine with blind-hem stitch capability  
*Please bring the instruction manual for your machine!*
- Size 60/8 or 70/10 sewing machine needle preferred
- Open toe foot for machine
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Scissors for cutting fabric
- Machine bobbin wound with white or ecru 50/2 thread
- Straight pins
- Trolley needle, finger stiletto or stiletto (optional, but helpful)
- Tweezers (optional)
- Iron and ironing surface
- Thread snips
- Pencil and eraser
